




# Number of Employers 2019-2023

#### Employers with 1-99 Employees





## Number of Self-Employed Businesses 2018-2023








# 2018 – 2022 Building Permits Value (\$000)

Total values of new construction for years 2018-2022









aged 15 years and over by industry - Sectors - North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) 2017 - 25% sample data





## **Total Labour Force (NOC)**









#### **Education - Highest Attainment**












